

Handle your Silver Jewellery with Care



- Manual activities—Remove jewellery during cooking, household cleaning, etc. to prevent its contact with sweat, perspiration & chemicals.
- Bathing or applying makeup – Colognes, Perfumes, Hairspray, Cosmetics, Soap and lotion can contain chemicals that can often react and damage jewellery, therefore wear them after your makeup to prevent exposure and damage.
- Sporting activities – Chlorinated water, perspiration can damage the metal and the polish of the jewellery.

How to reduce chance of tarnishing?

- Pure sterling silver jewellery has a tendency to tarnish especially when it's not worn.
- To maintain the luster of your jewellery, place it in re-sealable poly-bags before putting them into a container to prevent

How to store your precious Jewellery?



- It is important to store pieces separately, in a fabric-lined jewellery box or a chamois bag to prevent scratches.
- Your jewellery should be the first thing you take off at night and the last thing you put on in the morning - this will help you to maintain it.
- Check your jewellery periodically and if you find any gemstone/diamond that is loose or not set properly, get it repaired immediately.
- When travelling, wrap your jewellery individually in soft cloth or small cases to avoid any impact damage.

Handle your Gold Jewellery with Care



- Gold is naturally sensitive, keep your gold jewellery away from creams, lotions, make-up, and perfumes.
- Keep it away from sunlight as it causes the shine to diminish.
- Remove your jewellery before going to bed and while doing physical activities.

How to clean your Gold Jewellery?



- Use a solution of warm water and detergent free soap.
- Use soft bristled brush to clean out the stains.
- For tougher stains, sock it in water for 3-4 mins before running it under running water.
- After cleaning and rinsing, always dry it with soft cloth to avoid scratches and bring out its shine.

Handle your Diamond Jewellery with Care



- Try not to touch your diamonds, you pass oil from your fingers to the diamond, which can make it look dull.
- Take your diamond jewellery off while doing any physical activities, exercising, washing hands, etc.
- When getting ready in the morning, put your jewellery on last. Using makeup, fragrances, hairspray, and lotions around your jewellery can damage it.

How to clean your Diamond Jewellery?



- Make a cleaning solution with dishwasher soap and warm water.
- Soak the diamond in to solution for 5 minutes.
- Scrub the jewellery with help of soft brush.
- Rinse and Dry it with soft cloth.

Handle your Platinum Jewellery with Care



- Don't touch your platinum jewellery now and then. As platinum is polished, it attracts things like fingerprints easily.
- While it is the strongest of jewellery metals, platinum can scratch. However, the metal is only displaced, not lost. Avoid placing your platinum jewellery with other pieces that can scratch it.
- Over time, platinum jewellery tends to scratch and develop a layer called patina which takes on a grayish, matte-finish look. However, the shine can be restored by simple polishing and make your jewellery as good as new.

How to clean your Platinum Jewellery?



- Platinum is very easy to care for.
- Soaking platinum in a mild solution of soap and warm water and gently scrubbing it with a soft-bristled brush is usually all that is required to maintain the metal's lustre.
- However, be careful while cleaning the diamonds/gemstones set in platinum jewellery.
